Colt Starting with Scott Daily

The 20th Annual New Mexico Ag Expo is pleased to bring Scott Daily of Arkansas City, KS to present his program on "Starting Colts – Putting on the First Ride and Progressing the Young Horse." Scott Daily has been around horses most of his life. His love for horses and desire to train them began in 4-H while he was growing up in Inola, Oklahoma. Scott started training horses about 15 years ago.

"I had many different horses that I had to work with while in 4-H and during those years. I grew to love helping horses develop and become their best." To further his knowledge of horses, Scott attended Northeastern A&M College in Miami, OK and received a degree in Equine Management. He also competed for the rodeo Team while in college. After many years of working with challenging colts and horses, Scott has developed and perfected his own techniques. One method in particular involves laying the horse down while cracking a bullwhip or shooting a gun over the horse. The object of this action is to eliminate fears of loud noise and movement. Scott also feels this helps to build trust between horse and rider. The starting and training techniques he provides allows the horses to progress in a positive and willing manner. Scott Daily will present his demonstration on Tuesday, February 21st at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. in the Pavilion on the Roosevelt County Fairgrounds.
