2012 Silage Outlook & Planning for Dry Years

The 20th Annual New Mexico Ag Expo is pleased Dr. Mark Marsalis, New Mexico State Extension Agronomist to discuss, "The 2012 Silage Outlook and How to Plan for Dry Years". Dr. Marsalis will cover silage crop management in limited water settings. He will also cover 1st year data on a dryland corn study looking at the effects of the timing of rainfall on plant development and productivity.
